The School:

Established in 2005, the International School Augsburg has grown from 60 students to 360 students in the past twelve years. The school provides an international education in an English language learning environment for students from Kindergarten to Grade 12. ISA serves the local and international communities of the Augsburg, Donauwörth and Landsberg areas. Our student population comprises over 22 nationalities.

Facility and Facilities:

ISA's 57 teachers come from Australia, Canada, England, Finland, France, Germany, India, Ireland, Kenya, Korea, Netherlands, New Zealand, Poland, Portugal, Scotland, Spain, Syria, Tanzania and the United States. Most of them have taught at other international schools throughout the world. ISA actively promotes the professional development of its faculty.

The school's facilities contain classrooms, science labs, music rooms, an art room, computer lab, a school library, a cafeteria and full sports facilities for the athletics program.

Accreditation:

ISA is a private international school approved by the Bavarian Ministry of Education and is an IB authorized school. The school is a member of the Association of German International Schools (AGIS) and is accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS).

The Academic Programme:

The Grade 9-10 curriculum is guided by Cambridge International Exams, International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) programme, supplemented by ISA developed subject curriculum. The Grade 11 and Grade 12 curriculum follows the IB Diploma Programme.

The IB Diploma Programme:

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP) is a comprehensive two-year course of study. Students must successfully complete six externally examined courses, at least three at Higher Level and three at Standard Level, as well as the requirements of the "Core": an Extended Essay based on original research, Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS).
